

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Program Overview

Each PD course kicks off with a live virtual class followed by two or three asynchronous activities for participants to complete throughout the week. If it's a multi-week course, there will be a live class and activities for each week. Participants will collaborate with each other and get feedback from their Moreland instructor, revising their activities and assignments as needed.

At the end of the course, any participant who attended each class and completed the assignments will earn the allotted CEUs.
